Below are some ideas of what to put into the boxes:

Adult male/female:

Face mask, hand sanitizer, antibacterial wipes, gloves, hat, socks, lip balm, hand cream, sweets, chocolate, note pad & pen, roll on deodorant, shower gel, shampoo, conditioner, hand warmers, tissues, bubble bath

Child:

Face mask, hand sanitizer, small toys, hat, gloves, scarves, colouring books, pens, sweets, chocolate
