Week 6: Extinct



We read a range of books every day in Nursery but this is the text that we base some of our learning around and look at in depth. We will learn the story and discuss the events within the story too.







In phonics ...

In nursery this half term we are going to start our Read Write Inc (RWI) sessions. Read Write Inc is a programme that Outwood schools adopt which will help the children learn sounds which will aid children to be able to read. Please look at Google Classroom where I have put links to videos and helpful tips for parents when we teach RWI.

In writing ...

In nursery we focus on mark making. We encourage the children to make marks on the paper, telling us what they have drawn. We will discuss how to improve their drawings and other things to add. We encourage the children to write their own name or some letters of their name to identify pictures that they draw.

In maths ...

Each half term we focus our learning on a particular number to ensure that the children consolidate their understanding of that number.

After half term our number will be 3. Children will see the number represented in many different ways in nursery. Feel free to show 3 in different ways at home eg. 3 conkers, tally mark for 3, 3 dots, number two written as a word. We will also make a pattern using 3, share 3 items and subitise 3. We will be doing these activities practically in sessions and in and around the nursery setting.

Reminders

- Please ensure that everything that your child brings to school is labelled, this avoids belongings going missing. We have had lots of missing cardigans and jumpers recently.
- Please remember that as the weather turns colder, children need coats, hats, gloves and scarfs as we try and go outside as much as possible.
